- 3. Keep your NILICO insurance policy effective. NILICO provides a FREE Accidental Death & Dismemberment (AD&D) insurance policy (up to \$4,000) to all paid club members. (With family memberships, it covers all family members.)
- 4. Get discounts (tires, parts, hotels, camping, Disney tickets, car rentals, cruises, insurance, safe driving course, hearing services, baseball tickets, gifts, flowers) while you wait for snow.
