Reasons to join the club and register your snowmobile now.

1. Join the club now and get your voucher now.
2. Register your snowmobile now
 - a. **It is before the December 1 deadline, which ensures funding for trail maintenance.**
 - b. Before you lose the renewal that just came in the mail.
 - c. You will be ready to go when there is snow.
 - d. Your sticker will stick better when it's warm.
3. Keep your NILICO insurance policy effective. NILICO provides a FREE Accidental Death & Dismemberment (AD&D) insurance policy (up to \$4,000) to all paid club members. (With family memberships, it covers all family members.)
4. Get discounts (tires, parts, hotels, camping, Disney tickets, car rentals, cruises, insurance, safe driving course, hearing services, baseball tickets, gifts, flowers, and more) while you wait for snow.
